

The Structure of Judges

Judg. 20:11 So all the men of Israel (literally "man," איש, H0376) were gathered against the city, knit together as one man. 12 And the tribes of Israel (שבט, H7626) sent men through all the tribe of Benjamin, saying, What wickedness is this that is done among you? 13 Now therefore deliver us the men, the children of Belial, which are in Gibeah, that we may put them to death, and put away evil from Israel. But the children of Benjamin would not hearken to the voice of their brethren the children of Israel (בן, H1121):






