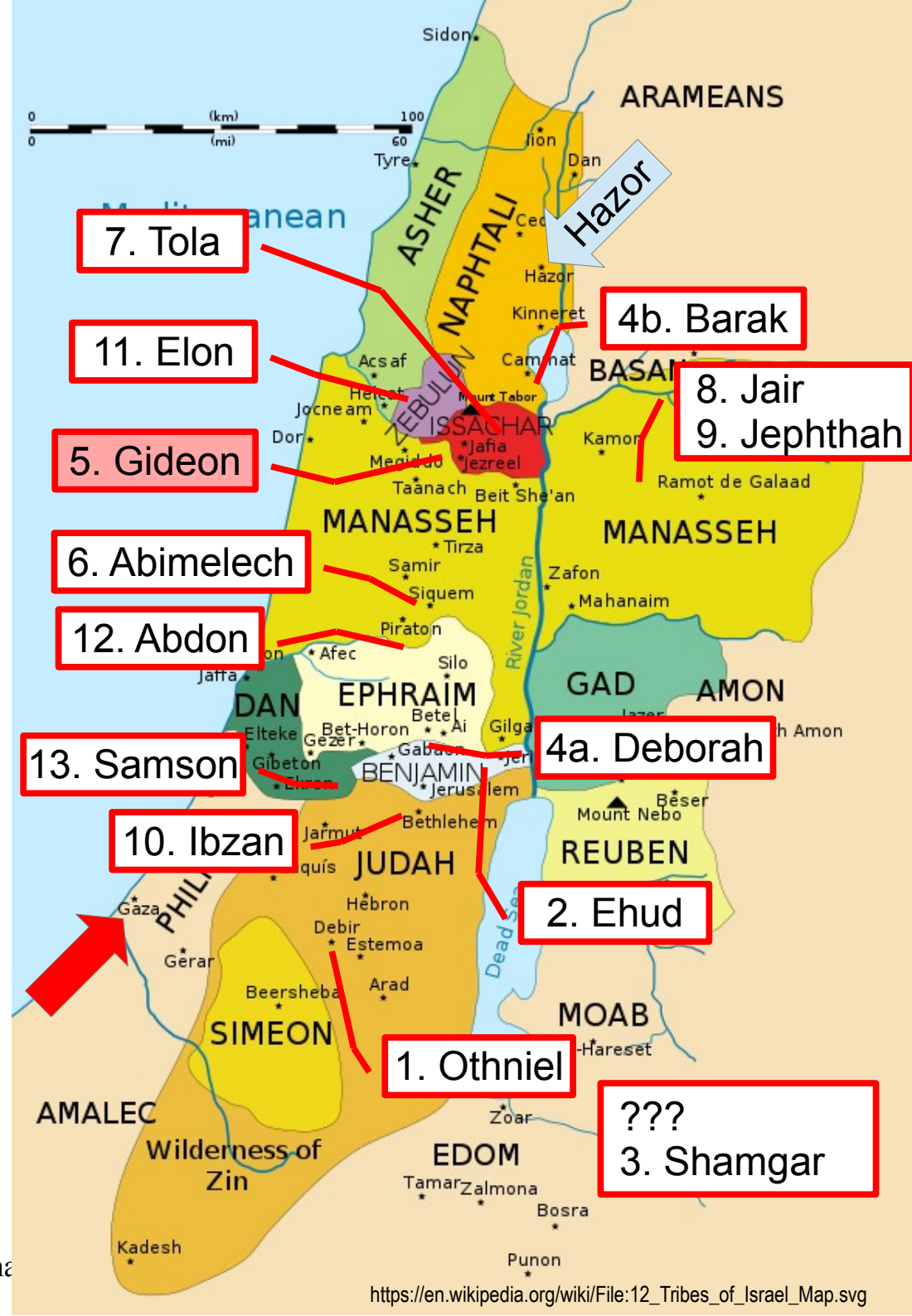


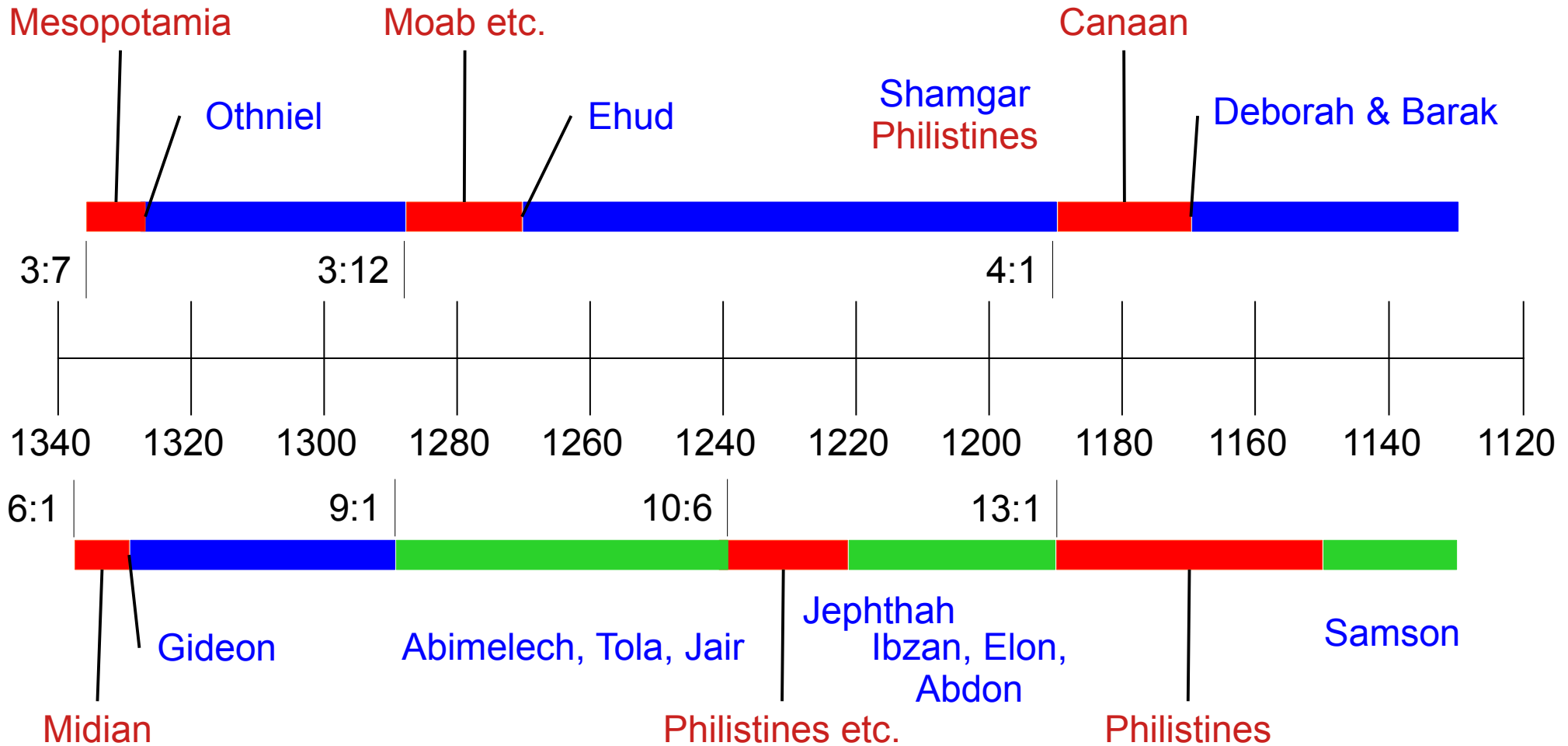
Why Barak? Jdg 6:1-10

Midian in the Bible

- Gen 37:38, Midianite merchants buy Joseph from his brothers
- Exodus 2-4, Moses flees to the land of Midian and marries a Midianite girl
- Numbers 22, Midian joins Moab in hiring Balaam to curse Israel
- Numbers 25, a Midianite woman seduces an Israelite
- Numbers 31, Israel fights against Midian.
- 1 Ki 11, Midian shelters Hadad the Edomite, adversary to Solomon.

Ex. 6:6 Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments: 7 **And I will take you to me for a people, and I will be to you a God**: and ye shall know that I am the LORD your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
