#### To Hager fleeing Sarah: "The Angel of the Lord"

Gen. 16:7 And **the angel of the LORD** found her by a fountain of water in the wilderness, by the fountain in the way to Shur. [+3x] ... 13 And she called the name of the LORD that spake unto her, **Thou God** seest me: for she said, Have I also here looked after him that seeth me?

To Abraham sacrificing Isaac:

Gen. 22:11 And **the angel of the LORD** called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here am I. 12 And he said, Lay not thine hand upon the lad, neither do thou any thing unto him: for now I know that thou fearest God, seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only son **from me**.

To Moses in Midian:

Ex. 3:2 And the angel of the LORD

appeared unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush burned with fire, and the bush was not consumed. ... 4 And when the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called unto him out of the midst of the bush, and said, Moses, Moses. And he said, Here am I

Rebuking Israel after conquest:

Judg. 2:1 And <del>an</del> the angel of the LORD came up from Gilgal to Bochim, and said, I made you to go up out of Egypt, and have brought you unto the land which I sware unto your fathers; and I said, I will never break my covenant with you.

Announcing birth of Samson:

Judg. 13:3 And the angel of the LORD appeared unto the woman, and said unto her, Behold now, thou art barren, and bearest not: but thou shalt conceive, and bear a son. [+11x] ... 22 And Manoah said unto his wife, We shall surely die, because we have seen God. 23 But his wife said unto him, If the **LORD** were pleased to kill us, he would not have received a burnt offering and a meat offering at our hands, neither would he have shewed us all these things, nor would as at this time have told us such things as these. Mic. 5:2 But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that
