Man as God's Appointed Governor

Gen. 1:26 And God said,

Let us make man in our image, after our likeness:

and let them **have dominion** over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth.

27 So God created man in his *own* **image**, in the **image** of God created he him; male and female created he them. 28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them,

Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and **subdue** it: and **have dominion** over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and **over every living thing** that moveth upon the earth.

The Ruler's Image

Mat 22:20 And he saith unto them, Whose *is* this image and superscription? 21 They say unto him, Caesar's. Then saith he unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's; and unto God the things that are God's.

Adam's Dominion

Demonstrated:

Gen 2:19 And out of the ground the LORD God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof. 20 And **Adam gave names** to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field;

To name is to claim authority:

- Gen. 17:1-5 the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect. ... 5 Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham;
- 2 Ki. 23:34 Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim the son of Josiah king in the room of Josiah his father, and **turned his name** to Jehoiakim,
- 2 Ki. 24:17 the king of Babylon made Mattaniah his father's brother king in his stead, and **changed his name** to Zedekiah.

Delimited:

Gen 2:16 And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: 17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Adam's Fall





Isa 11:1-8 and its Antecedents

1 And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots:

2 And the **spirit of the LORD** shall rest upon him, the **spirit** of wisdom and understanding, the **spirit** of counsel and might, the **spirit** of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;

3 And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears:

4 But with righteousness shall he **judge** the poor, and **reprove** with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked. 5 And righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and faithfulness the girdle of his reins.

The Problem: Israel's Confession, Isaiah 59

Isa 59:12 For our transgressions are multiplied before thee, and our sins testify against us: for our transgressions *are* with us; and *as for* our iniquities, we know them; 13 In transgressing and lying against the LORD, and departing away from our God, speaking oppression and revolt, conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood. 14 And judgment is turned away backward, and justice standeth afar off: for truth is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter. 15 Yea, truth faileth; and he *that* departeth from evil maketh himself a prey:

The Diagnosis:

15 and the LORD saw *it*, and it displeased him that *there was* no judgment. 16 And **he saw that** *there was* no man, and wondered that *there was* no intercessor:

The Intervention:

16 therefore his arm brought salvation unto him; and his righteousness, it sustained him. 17 For he put on righteousness as a breastplate, and an helmet of salvation upon his head; and he put on the garments of vengeance *for* clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloke. 18 According to *their* deeds, accordingly he will repay, fury to his adversaries, recompence to his enemies; to the islands he will repay recompence. 19 So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him. 20 And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the LORD.

The Solution:

21 As for me, this *is* **my covenant** with them, saith the LORD; **My spirit** that *is* upon thee, and **my words** which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the LORD, from henceforth and for ever.

Institution at the Last Supper:

Eph 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast. 10 For we are his workmanship, **created in Christ Jesus unto good works**, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Daniel 7:1-7: Back to the Zoo

Dan 7:1 In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon Daniel had a dream and visions of his head upon his bed: then he wrote the dream, and told the sum of the matters. 2 Daniel spake and said, I saw in my vision by night, and, behold, the four winds of the heaven strove upon the great sea. 3 And four great beasts came up from the **sea**, diverse one from another.

7 After this I saw in the night visions, and behold a fourth **beast**, dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it was diverse from all the beasts that were before it; and it had ten horns.

Dan. 7:9 I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the **Ancient of days** did sit, whose garment *was* white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne *was like* the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire. ...

13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the a Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. 14 And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

Psa 90:1 Lord, thou hast been our dwelling place in all generations. 2 Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even **from everlasting to everlasting**, thou *art* God.

Dan 7:15-28, The Explanation

15 I Daniel was grieved in my spirit in the midst of *my* body, and the visions of my head **troubled me.**

16 I came near unto one of them that stood by, and asked him the truth of all this. So he told me, and made me know the interpretation of the things. 17 These great beasts, which are four, are four kings, which shall arise out of the earth. 18 But the saints of the most High shall take the kingdom, and possess the kingdom for ever, even for ever and ever. ... 27 And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose [singular] kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him. 28 Hitherto is the end of the matter.

As for me Daniel, my cogitations much **troubled me**, and my countenance changed in me: but I kept the matter in my heart.

Gen 14:19 And he blessed him, and said, Blessed *be* Abram of the **most high God**, possessor of heaven and earth:

Dan 4:17 **the most High** ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, (cf. vv. 24, 25, 32)

Dan 4:34 And at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the most High, and I praised and honoured him that liveth for ever, whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, and his kingdom is from generation to generation:

Dan 7:14 And there was given him [one like a son of man] dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

What makes the difference?

Phil. 2:8-11 he humbled himself, and became **obedient unto death, even the death of the cross**. 9 **Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him**, and given him a name which is above every name: 10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, ...

Heb. 2:9 for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour;

What message were the disciples to preach?


Matt. 24:14 And **this gospel of the kingdom** shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.



Isa 61:1 ~ Luke 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord GOD *is* upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to **preach good tidings** unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound;

The Gospel as Removal of the Usurper

Mat 12:28-29 But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you. 29 Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man? and then he will spoil his house.

Joh 12:31-33 Now is the judgment of this world: **now shall the prince of this world be cast out.**

Col 2:15 And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, **triumphing over them in it.**

Heb 2:14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

Repentance in the Apostolic Message

Luk 24:46 [Jesus] said unto them ... 47 ... that **repentance** and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

To Jews:

[Pentecost] Act 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, **Repent**, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

[Solomon's porch] Act 3:19 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out.

[to the Sanhedrin:] Act 5:31 [Jesus] hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give **repentance** to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. [note the similarity to Luke 24:47]

To Gentiles:

[after Cornelius's salvation:] Act 11:18 When they heard these things, they held their peace, and glorified God, saying, Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted **repentance** unto life.

[Paul in Athens:] Act 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to **repent**:

[Paul to the Ephesian elders:] Act 20:19 ... I ... have shewed you, and have taught you publickly, and from house to house, 21 Testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, **repentance** toward God, and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ.

[Before Agrippa:] Act 26:19 Whereupon, O king Agrippa, I was not disobedient unto the heavenly vision: 20 But shewed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and *then* to the Gentiles, that they should **repent** and turn to God, and do works meet for **repentance**.

The Kingdom of God in the Apostolic Message

Act 8:12 But when they believed Philip **preaching** the things concerning **the kingdom of God**, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, ...

Act 14:21 And when they had preached the gospel to that city, and had taught many, they returned again to Lystra, and to Iconium, and Antioch, 22 Confirming the souls of the disciples, and exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the kingdom of God.

Act 19:8 And [Paul] went into the synagogue [in Ephesus], and spake boldly for the space of three months, disputing and persuading the things concerning the kingdom of God.

Act 28:23 And when they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into *his* lodging; to whom he expounded and testified **the kingdom of God**, persuading them concerning Jesus, both out of the law of Moses, and *out of* the prophets, ...

Act 28:30 And Paul dwelt two whole years in his own hired house, and received all that came in unto him, 31 Preaching the kingdom of God, and teaching those things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ, with all confidence, no man forbidding him.

Act 20:24 But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God. 25 And now, behold, I know that ye all, among whom I have gone preaching the kingdom of God, shall see my face no more.



The Law and the Prophets

5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. ...

7:12a Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them:

7:12b for this is the law and the prophets.

What is "this" in 7:12b?

- Is it 7:12a? Then what about 22:37?
 - 22:37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. 38 This is the first and great commandment. 39 And the second *is* like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. 40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.
- Better: everything between 5:20 and 7:12b
