# 2:22-23, 24-25, The Doctrine at Stake

### **Jesus is the Christ (the Anointed)**

Mat 1:21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name **JESUS**: for he shall save his people from their sins.

Psa 2:2 The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his **anointed**, ... 7 I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, Thou art **my Son**; this day have I begotten thee.

### The Essential Deity of the Lord Jesus

Jhn 8:24 I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that **I am** he, ye shall die in your sins.

Jhn 8:58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.

Exo 3:13 And Moses said unto God, Behold, when I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, The God of your fathers hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, What is his name? what shall I say unto them? 14 And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

### **Having God**

Psa. 73:26 My flesh and my heart faileth: but God is the strength of my heart, and **my portion** for ever.

Psa 16:5 The LORD is the portion of **mine inheritance** and of my cup: thou maintainest my lot.

Jer 31:33 but this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the Lord, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

### The Abiding Word

Jhn 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. Jhn 5:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.




# Defining Righteousness in the First Two Panels

# The Righteousness of Christ

Jhn 8:46 Which of you convinceth me of sin?

Mat 27:24 When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just [righteous] person: see ye to it.

Heb 4:15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, **yet without sin.** 

# The Righteousness of God

Psa 40:10 I have not hid thy **righteousness** within my heart;

I have declared thy faithfulness and thy salvation:

Psa 71:15 My mouth shall shew forth thy righteousness and thy salvation all the day;

Psa 98:2 The LORD hath made known his salvation: his **righteousness** hath he openly shewed in the sight of the heathen.

Jer 23:6 In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR **RIGHTEOUSNESS**.


# **Imputed Righteousness**

2Co 5:21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the **righteousness** of God in him.


# **Practical Righteousness**
