### The Sermon's Chiastic Frame

#### "...not as the scribes"

Compare the first issue discussed in the Mishnah (Berachot 1:1):

From what time is the שׁמע to be said in the evening?

- From the time the priests again enter [the sanctuary] to eat their heave offerings, until the close of the first watch [of the night].
   Such is the dictum of R. Eleazar;
- but the sages say, "until midnight."
- Rabbon Gamaliel saith, "until the break of dawn."

### Disciples vs. Multitudes

Compare 5:1-2 ("his disciples came, and he ... taught them") with 7:28 ("the multitudes were astonished at his doctrine")

Another example of the same behavior:

Mar 6:30 And the apostles gathered themselves together unto Jesus, and told him all things, both what they had done, and what they had taught. 31 And he said unto them, **Come ye yourselves apart** into a desert place, and rest a while: **for there were many** coming and going, and they had no leisure so much as to eat. 32 And they departed into a desert place by ship privately. 33 **And the people saw them departing**, and many knew him, and ran afoot thither out of all cities, and outwent them, **and came together unto him**.

## Stages of Popularity

Early popularity (before feeding of 5000):

Mat 4:25 And there followed him great multitudes of people

Matt 8:1 great multitudes followed him

Counting the cost (after feeding of the 5000):

Joh 6:66 From that *time* many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him.

The ultimate test:

Mat 26:56 Then all the disciples forsook him, and fled.






