Psalm 90, An Eternal Dwelling for a Short-Lived People

- 1-2, The Eternal Lord
- 3-6, **Return** us to yourself: short life
- 7-12, God's wrath against sin
- 13-17, **Return** to us: enduring works

90:3 Thou **turnest** man to destruction (dust)

Gen 3:19 In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou **return** unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou **return**.

90:3 return, ye children of men

Psa 80:(3, 7,) 19 **Turn us again**, O LORD God of hosts, cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved.

90:13 Return, O Lord

Psa 80:14 **Return**, we beseech thee, O God of hosts:

Psa 80:4 O LORD God of hosts, **how long** wilt thou be angry against the prayer of thy people?


