

Who is speaking to Whom?

- 18:10, kings to Babylon: "in one hour is thy judgment come"
- 18:22-23, a mighty angel to Babylon (five times)
- → Probably to Babylon, either by the merchants or by the heavenly voice of 18:4-8

Who Moved?


Job 1:21 And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and **naked shall I return** thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD.

Eccl 5:15 As he came forth of his mother's womb, **naked shall he return** to go as he came, and shall take nothing of his labour, which he may carry away in his hand.

9a, kings ... lived deliciously

15a, merchants ... were made rich

17b, seamen ... trade by sea

Their Fear: 10, 15, 17: stand afar off

Psa 38:11 My lovers and my friends stand aloof from my sore; and my kinsmen stand afar off.

Mat 27:55 And many women were there beholding **afar off**, which followed Jesus from Galilee, ministering unto him: ... (Mark 15:40; Luke 23:49)

Jhn 19:25 Now there stood by the cross of Jesus his mother, and his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Cleophas, and Mary Magdalene. 26 When Jesus therefore saw his mother, and the disciple standing by, whom he loved, he saith unto his mother, Woman, behold thy son! Her Smoke (2x); Their Lament

9b, kings ... bewail, lament

15c, merchants ... weeping and wailing


18a, seamen ... cried; 19a cast dust; cried, weeping and wailing

Their Cry: Alas, Alas (G3759, = "woe")

Rev 8:13 And I beheld, and heard an angel eagle flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, **Woe, woe, woe,** to the inhabiters of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound!

1Kings 13:30 And he laid his carcase in his own grave; and they mourned over him, saying, **Alas**, my brother!

Jer. 22:18 Therefore thus saith the LORD concerning Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah; They shall not lament for him, saying, **Ah** my brother! or, **Ah** sister! they shall not lament for him, saying, **Ah** lord! or, **Ah** his glory! 19 He shall be buried with the burial of an ass, drawn and cast forth beyond the gates of Jerusalem.




The "Great City"

10c, kings: mighty city; 16b, merchants: clothed ...; 19b, seamen: had ships Rev. 3:12 Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name.

Rev. 21:10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me **that great city**, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

Avenging the Martyrs

Rev 18:20 God hath avenged you on her judged your judgment from her



Rev 6:10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?

Rev 19:2 For true and righteous are his judgments: for he hath **judged** the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath **avenged** the blood of his servants at her hand.
