Lessons from the Doxologies

Persecution leads to **Praise**

Psa 76:10 Surely the wrath of man shall praise thee: the remainder of wrath shalt thou restrain.

The Lamb is **Equal** with God

4:10-11 God: glory, honor, power

5:12 Lamb: power, ... honor, glory

The Lamb is **Powerful**

Worthy ... to receive power ... Four Words for power

We should praise God Fully

We **bless** him for his **benefits** (what he does for us)

We **thank** him for his **attributes** (who he is)

The Lamb will rule on Earth

Wisdom, Riches, Strength ἰσχύς (physical might)

Pro 3:19 The LORD **by wisdom** hath founded the earth;

by understanding hath he established the heavens.
20 By his knowledge the depths are broken up, and the clouds drop down the dew.

Gen 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion
